ing in the mail and newspaper, watering plants, checking for forced entry and checking that appliances and utilities are functioning), pick up and drop off services of prescriptions, dry cleaning, movies and forgotten lunches or homework; concierge services, including ticket purchases, car rentals, dining reservations, travel research and reservations;

and clerical services, such as running to the post office, bank or town office, appointment scheduling, bill paying, Internet research and correspondence.

Spencer said she got the idea for starting the errand service when she was a single mother of two children and worked full time. She realized there were not enough hours in the day to do all

that needed to be done. She thought how nice it would be to have someone do the errands for her, so she could spend her time doing the things she wanted to do.
